## **Downloading the Source from CVS**

This article describes how one would download the sources.

## Get the code

- i. Install TortoiseSVN
- ii. Create a folder Ecopath\_dev/<project\_name>
- iii. Right click on the <project\_name> and select SVN Checkout
- iv. Choose one of the URLs corresponding to the cproject\_name> and enter it in URL of Repository:

Ecopath6: ?https://sources.ecopath.org:8443/svn/Ecopath/trunk/Ecopath6

Ecopath5: <a href="https://sources.ecopath.org:8443/svn/Ecopath/trunk/Ecopath5">https://sources.ecopath.org:8443/svn/Ecopath/trunk/Ecopath5</a>

Click OK and enter your username and password

A WinCVS alternative to SVN would be RapidSVN but requires a pre-released version (9.9): <a href="http://www.rapidsvn.org/download/nightly/win32/">http://www.rapidsvn.org/download/nightly/win32/</a>
