

## Downloading the Source from CVS

This article describes how one would download the sources.

Get the code

- i. Install [?TortoiseSVN](#)
- ii. Create a folder Ecopath\_dev/<project\_name>
- iii. Right click on the <project\_name> and select SVN Checkout
- iv. Choose one of the URLs corresponding to the <project\_name> and enter it in URL of Repository:

Ecopath5: [?https://sources.ecopath.org:8443/svn/Ecopath/trunk/Ecopath5](https://sources.ecopath.org:8443/svn/Ecopath/trunk/Ecopath5)

Click OK and enter your username and password
