## Downloading the Source from CVS

This article describes how one would download the sources.

Get the code

- i. Install <u>?TortoiseSVN</u> (Version 1.6.5 preferred)
- ii. Create a folder Ecopath\_dev/<project\_name>
- iii. Right click on the <project\_name> and select SVN Checkout
- iv. Choose one of the URLs corresponding to the <project\_name> and enter it in URL of Repository:

Ecopath6: <a href="https://sources.ecopath.org">https://sources.ecopath.org</a>:8443/svn/Ecopath/trunk/Ecopath6

Ecopath5: <a>?https://sources.ecopath.org</a>:8443/svn/Ecopath/trunk/Ecopath5

Click OK and enter your username and password
