- i. Install <a>?TortoiseSVN (Version 1.6.5 preferred)
- ii. Create a folder Ecopath_dev/cproject_name>. The project name is either 'Ecopath6' or 'Ecopath5' as listed below.
- iii. Right click on the <project_name> and select SVN Checkout
- iv. Choose one of the URLs corresponding to the <project_name> and enter it in URL of Repository:

Click OK and enter your username and password
