- <u>Download sources from SVN</u> Download the EwE sources from our central SVN server.
- <u>Install Visual Basic Express</u> Visual Basic Express is the development environment that we use to program EwE. This is required if you want to program or look into the source code of EwE.
- <u>Install Access drivers</u> Make sure your system has the Access 2007 drivers installed that EwE needs.
- Run EwE6 from sources This article describes how to run the scientific interface from the sources.
